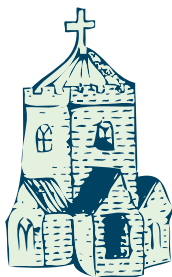
Information Pack

Shropshire Archives is the archives and local studies service for the county of Shropshire and the Borough of Telford & Wrekin, holding 5 ½ miles of material relating to Shropshire from the 12th century to the present day.

Our Information Packs contain copies of primary and secondary source material for particular topics or themes. Designed as a teachers' resource and for classroom use, they can be tailored for use from Key Stage 1 through to 'A' level.

For any topic to which you wish to give a Shropshire slant or to study in depth, we can advise on the availability of source material. Recent packs have included 'Evacuees in Shropshire in World War 2', 'Birmingham-Liverpool Canal at Market Drayton', 'The Creation and Development of Telford' and 'The Fires of Wem', 'Church Stretton and the Railway'.

Information Packs vary in price depending on the topic, the sources available and the amount of material supplied. Kerry Dickins, our Librarian with responsibility for education, will be happy to discuss your requirements and advise on costs.
