Castles and Dragons



Children spend the day with an experienced museum educator finding out, in a very practical way, that homes were different a long time ago and that materials are chosen for specific purposes on the basis of their properties.

Suitable for KS1. Supports the QCA History unit 2, *What were homes like a long time ago?* QCA Science unit 1C *Sorting and using materials.*



Children will:

- Dress up in medieval costumes.
- Lay a medieval banqueting table with wooden plates and bowls, pewter plates and spoons, horn mugs and leather tankards, silver candlesticks, rich tablecloths and replica food.
- Learn a medieval dance to medieval music.
- Hear a dragon's roar.
- Listen to a story of George and the Dragon.
- Visit the Mammoth bones (the nearest we can get to dragon bones!) in a 'behind the scenes' tour of the climate controlled museum stores. See how big they are!
- Visit Ludlow Castle for a special guided tour of the icehouse, dungeon, kitchen and well, great hall, bedrooms, and best of all, the garderobe!
- Look at the stone windows, the massive doorways and fireplaces and compare them with homes today.
